### a. What you need to know

- i. With the upcoming feature, the GCP Project links, service links, and login configurations used to perform authentication to GCP Projects will be updated.
- ii. The links will be automatically updated for the applications after the changes are applied to your projects.
- iii. The active user session for users will be available for 8 hours instead of 4 hours.
- iv. We are transitioning from ``//iam.googleapis.com/locations/global/workforcePools/rdl-identity-mng-prod/providers/rdl-kc-prod`` to ``//iam.googleapis.com/locations/global/workforcePools/aiip-identity-management-prod/providers/aiip-provider-prod``
- v. These changes will be rolled out for each existing project starting on **May 12, 2025**.

- i. GCP Project links and service links available on the AI Innovation Platform application will be automatically updated to the new links. Please update any bookmarked links from your end.
- ii. Gcloud SDK login configurations will be updated to the new links. Once the new links are rolled out for your project, please update your configurations to the latest version. Note: Please update this after the new links are available for your project.
